- 1. Read a mystery book of your choice.
- 2. Decorate a box with details from your book. (shoe box size) Your box must have a lid that you can lift off or open and close. Think about that when you are wrapping and/or decorating the outside of it. You will need to be able to put things into the box when you are creating it. You need to be able to open the box to get to your mystery items when you are showing the class.
- 3. Here are the things you must put on the OUTSIDE of your box:
 - √ your name
 - ✓ main characters write their names and include a picture of each of them
 (pictures can be drawn, cut out, or taken from the internet)
 - \checkmark at least three pictures of any other significant facts or details
- 4. Here are the things you must put INSIDE your box:
 - ✓ the attached book report form, filled out You can keep your answers simple, but
 you must write in complete sentences. I want your BEST handwriting. Ask your
 parents for help with spelling.
 - ✓ at least three items that will help you tell us about the book. For example, if your book has to do with dinosaurs, you can include a toy dinosaur. If your main character uses a flashlight, you can include a flashlight. If you have a detective that uses a magnifying glass, put one in the box. Get the picture? You can make some items as well. Have fun being creative with this part of the report.
 - ✓ You have until October 31st to complete this book report. Don't bring them early.
 We don't want to spoil any surprises! Be ready to share!
- 5. Shhhhh...don't tell anyone the name of your book. That's the mystery! We want to keep them guessing!
