- ✓ praise and thank - this is the last thing we do in the Sacrament of Reconciliation
We thank the priest. We thank and praise God in our hearts.
 - ✓ contrition - sorrow for sin (we are sorry)
 - ✓ sin - choosing to say no to God
 - ✓ confession - telling our sins to a priest
 - ✓ absolution - words of forgiveness that the priest says in the name of Jesus
 - ✓ temptation - feeling like doing something wrong
 - ✓ reconciliation - making up and becoming friends again
 - ✓ penance - prayers or good deeds done to make up for sin

- Jesus gave us the gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
 - The Holy Spirit helps us to look into our hearts to see how loving we have been.
 - The priest forgives us in the name of Jesus.
 - The Act of Contrition is a prayer that tells God that we are sorry.
 - Zacchaeus is a Gospel story that tells us that Jesus wants to forgive us.
 - We must be sorry for our sins in order to be forgiven.

Know these in order:

1. We confess our sins.
2. The priest gives us our penance.
3. We receive absolution.
